New laws and the overall education of the public about the treatment of mill dogs has resulted in an increase in the number of discarded dogs. Our goal is to rescue the unwanted breeding dog before they are dumped at our shelters, turned loose into our open spaces, mistreated or destroyed. K9MR works to provides the physical, mental and emotional care each individual dog needs to transition into a family forever home.

All of our dogs are spayed or neutered to end their contribution to overpopulation crisis in our communities.
