NEVER EVER LEAGUE 2

This program is an extension of the Never Ever League and is designed to bridge players who have completed Never Ever to organized league play. It has a heavier emphasis on instructional game time (80%) with on ice skill development (20%) used to fine tune playing skills. On ice sessions will utilize multiple scrimmages with on ice officials, which provide our coaching staff an opportunity to "teach from the bench" in real time. Players that complete this program will have full confidence to join our recreational adult league knowing that they are ready for friendly competition.





Our Learn to Skate Program is the starting point where participants learn the fundamental skills to move onto other programs.



LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAMS

There's no doubt about it, zooming around on the ice is a fantastic way to embrace winter and get some exercise at the same time. It is a lifelong activity that provides many positive benefits, so why not learn how to skate?

The Iceplex offers multiple programs for people with a desire to master the skill of ice skating. We have developed a world class program that provides all participants a positive atmosphere to achieve their goals, whether they are to simply learn to ice skate for fun, or to become a hockey player or figure skater.

Our instructional staff are trained professionals with a passion for ice sports. Their infectious attitude will give beginners a needed comfort level to succeed, while keeping each class fun and rewarding. The fundamental objectives of all of our learn to skate programs are;

- To provide a fun and safe skating experience for the beginner as well as the more advanced skater
- To teach correct technique of the simple basic elements
- To promote health and physical fitness
- To enable all participants to achieve the skills necessary to either skate for fun the rest of their lives or to move into our Learn to Play Hockey program or Figure Skating program.



SKATING 101

This is the entry level program for anyone looking to play ice hockey, figure skate or simply master the skills of ice skating for fun. It is designed for the beginner of all ages and run by our professionally trained ice hockey and figure skating instructional staff. Rental skates are provided at no cost (if needed) and each class is broken up by age and skill levels, creating a safe and enjoyable skating experience for all participants.

The Intro to Ice program is a learn to skate class designed specifically for home schooled children by our professional coaching staff. This program can fulfill required physical education credits in a fun and positive environment.

LEARN TO PLAY HOCKEY PROGRAMS

The program operates under the premise that if a player's introduction to the sport is positive, they will develop a lifetime love of the game.

Our hockey programs are taught by the Iceplex hockey staff, in partnership with Rochester Youth Hockey coaches, who are USA Hockey certified coaches with an extensive playing background. HOCKEY 101 (INITIATION PROGRAM)

Hockey 101 is our entry level Learn to Play Hockey program for children ages 4 to 12. Successful completion of the Skating 101 program is highly recommended, as participants should have mastered the fundamental skills of ice skating in order to thrive in a hockey environment. This program is designed with an emphasis on having fun, creating a positive atmosphere crucial for children to achieve the comfort levels needed to learn.

The focus of Hockey 101 is to develop each participant's individual skills and game tactics. This foundation of skills will enhance a player's enjoyment of the game and prepare them for Hockey 201, at which point they are introduced to team skills and game tactics.

This program is the next step towards playing organized youth hockey in a full season format.
