Two Color

andigo

The file name refers to the two PMS (Pantone Matching System) colors that make up andigo's primary color palette*. This is the file most vendors will need as part of the logo update process.

Available formats: .eps, high resolution (300dpi) .jpg

Four Color

andigo

Four color refers to the percentages of CMYK or Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Key (black) used to create this full color logo. This file format is used primarily by commercial presses when printing large quantities of marketing collateral.

RGB

For web use only. RGB refers to the universal system for representing the colors Red, Blue and Green on a computer display.

Available format: web-ready (72dpi) .jpg

White Only

Used when our logo will be placed on a color or pattered backroound.

Available formats: .eps, web-ready .png

Black Only

Used when a 3rd party intends to print only using black on white. Also used to produce the best quality on faxes or anything reproduced on a copy machine.
