Not only is 1886 Buffalo Café a favorite spot in Calgary for people to go and enjoy an amazing, home-style breakfast, it also represents a unique piece of local history.

Peter A. Prince, 1836-1925, was the manager of Eau Claire and Bow River Lumber. He built Calgary's first skyscraper, he built the first water wheel on the Bow River, he invented & patented the Sherboom (an important piece of logging equipment) and he built one of the first architecturally designed brick homes in Calgary.

Peter Prince was the president of Calgary Iron Works and partner in the large Prince-Kerr Ranch near Brooks (still owned by his relatives). At the young age of 80 he bought and learned to drive a Red Rambler, the first gas powered car in Calgary. And, as we all know, Prince's Island is named after Peter A. Prince.
