Unfortunately, this has led to misleading information and sub-standard Scrum training and certifications.

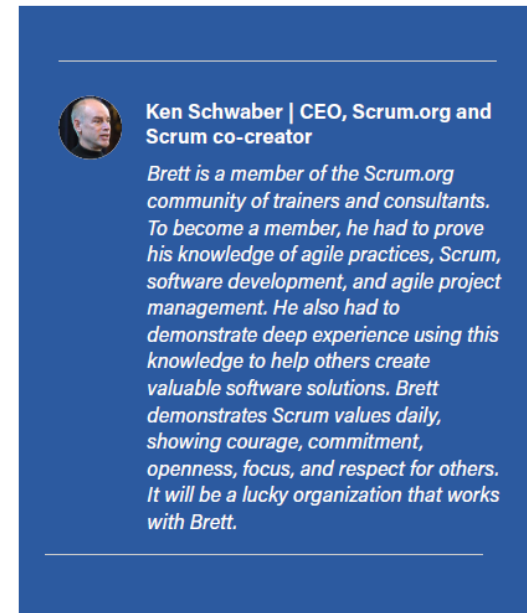
The co-creator of Scrum, Ken Schwaber, founded Scrum.org which today continues to be the main governing body of Scrum internationally.
