

Main page: Top navigation should change only slightly:

- IN Studio takes user to page of guests and audio – no change here
- Write IN is also the same
- Just IN should point to three possible pages: IN Feed, IN Favor, and INnovation Book. The section on INnovation techniques disappears.
- What's IN stays the same
