What Is our Mission?

Havens for Heroes is a Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program. We are a housing assistance program established to end homelessness for Veteran families and single Veterans in Alameda and Contra Costa counties.

This program is funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs.

What Services Can I Receive?

Services available through the program include:

- ✓ housing search and location
- ✓ short-term rental assistance and deposit assistance
- ✓ budgeting services
- ✓ utility deposits and assistance

Who Is Eligible?

- ☑ Be homeless (or at imminent risk of becoming homeless).
- ☑ Have a connection to Alameda or Contra Costa County (Applicants should live in either county or expect to live in either county).
- ☑ Head of household or spouse of head of household is a Veteran member (with a discharge other than dishonorable). A Veteran is someone who has served as active military service.
- ☑ Have a total household income (gross) of less than 50% of Area Median Income (AMI). For a single person, 50% of AMI is \$32,550; for a family of 4 it is \$46,450.
- ☑ Women and/or Veterans with dependent children are encouraged to apply.
