Start Here

The first step to connecting in Group Life is the **Alpha Course**. This 8-week course will give you the chance to explore life's biggest questions and get to know others at Beacon.

Follow-up Groups

Short term group of 2 or 3 new Christians led by a disciple-maker who helps them get firmly planted in their faith.

Discipleship Classes

A 3-year track of classes designed to help established Christians grow in their knowledge of Jesus, as well as Christian principles and practices.

Discipleship Groups

Long term group of 2 or 3 faithful, available, and teachable Christians led by a disciple-maker who helps them become missional disciple-makers.
