

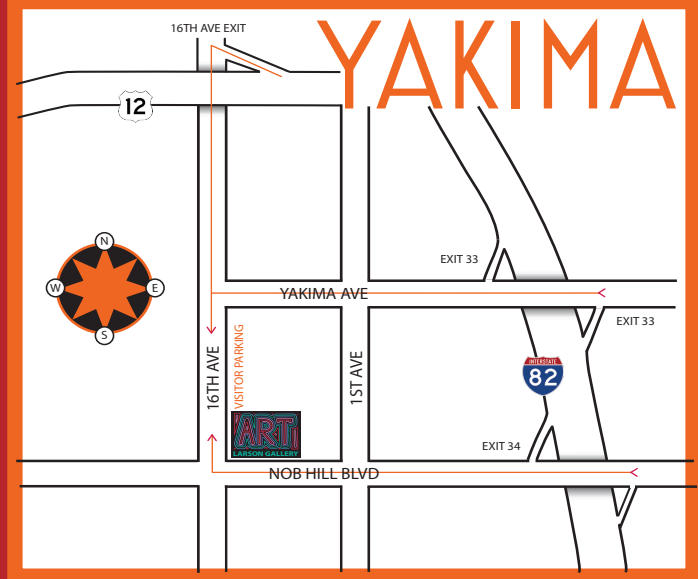
MEMBERSHIP

- May 18, 2017

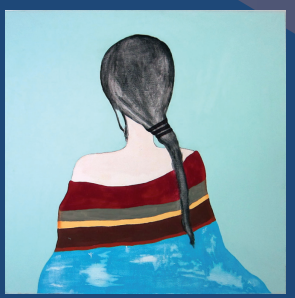
Hotel Maison
