Since we’re wrapping up, let’s look at the text and make the following changes:

1. Top of the poster, the line “Based on an original screenplay by Matthew Pundzak.” Modify that to read **“An original screenplay by Matthew Pundzak”** – no quotation marks. Same fonts/colors.
2. In your initial submission you included the tag line – “She finally found the man of her dreams. just one problem; he’s from the 1800s” and I asked you to remove it. After review, we decided that to update the tag line and reinsert it. Please insert the following tag line, no quotation marks, in the same position, using the same fonts as your original submission.

“She finally found the man of her dreams. Just one problem; he’s from the 1800s”
