

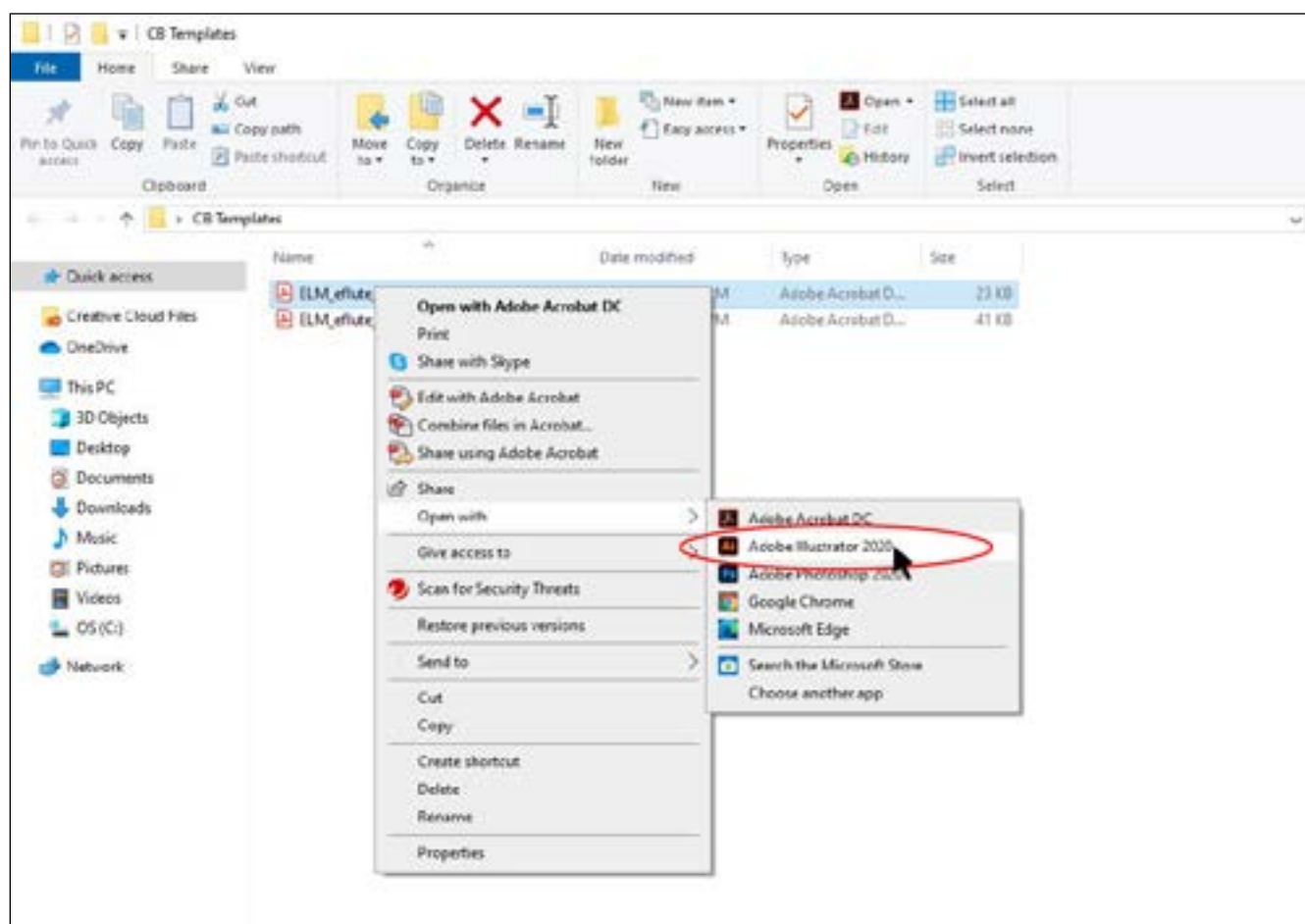
Steps to Transform Your Packaging

CompanyBox is excited you're here. Please read the information below to get started.

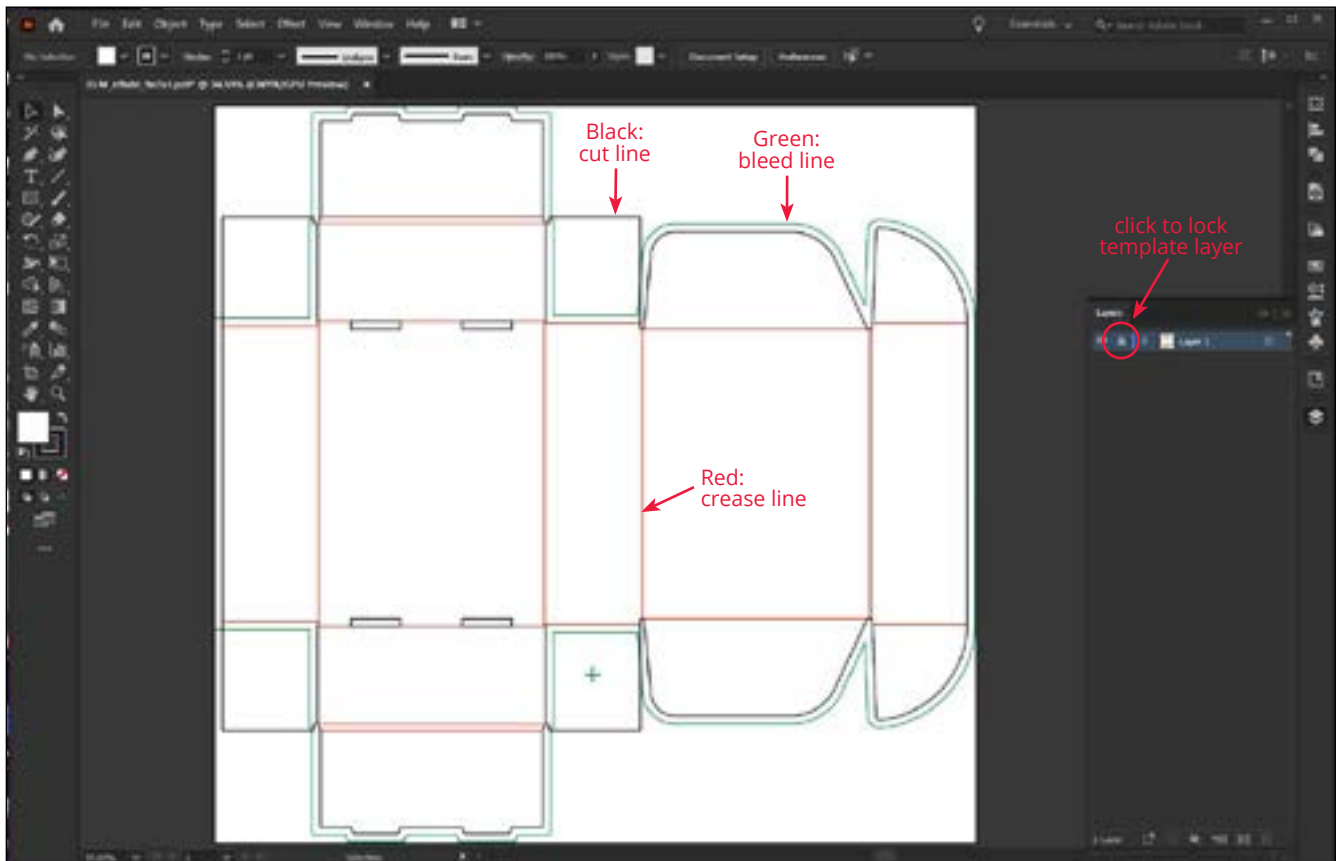
1. Choose the Inside or Outside PDF to design. Right click the PDF > Open with Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop or CorelDRAW.



Psst...We recommend Adobe Illustrator.



- Once opened, you will see the template with bleed, cut and crease lines. This is your die layer. Do not move or rotate these lines! Please do all your designing without rotating or scaling the template to fit artwork.



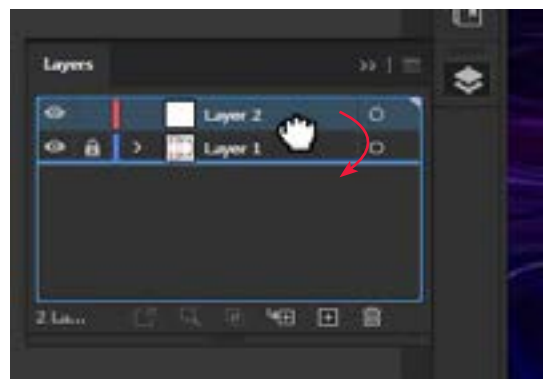
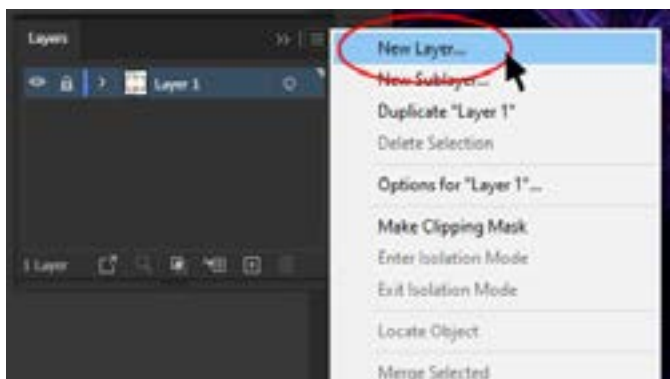
These die lines are color coded for our printer:

Black = Cut line (where the actual box ends)

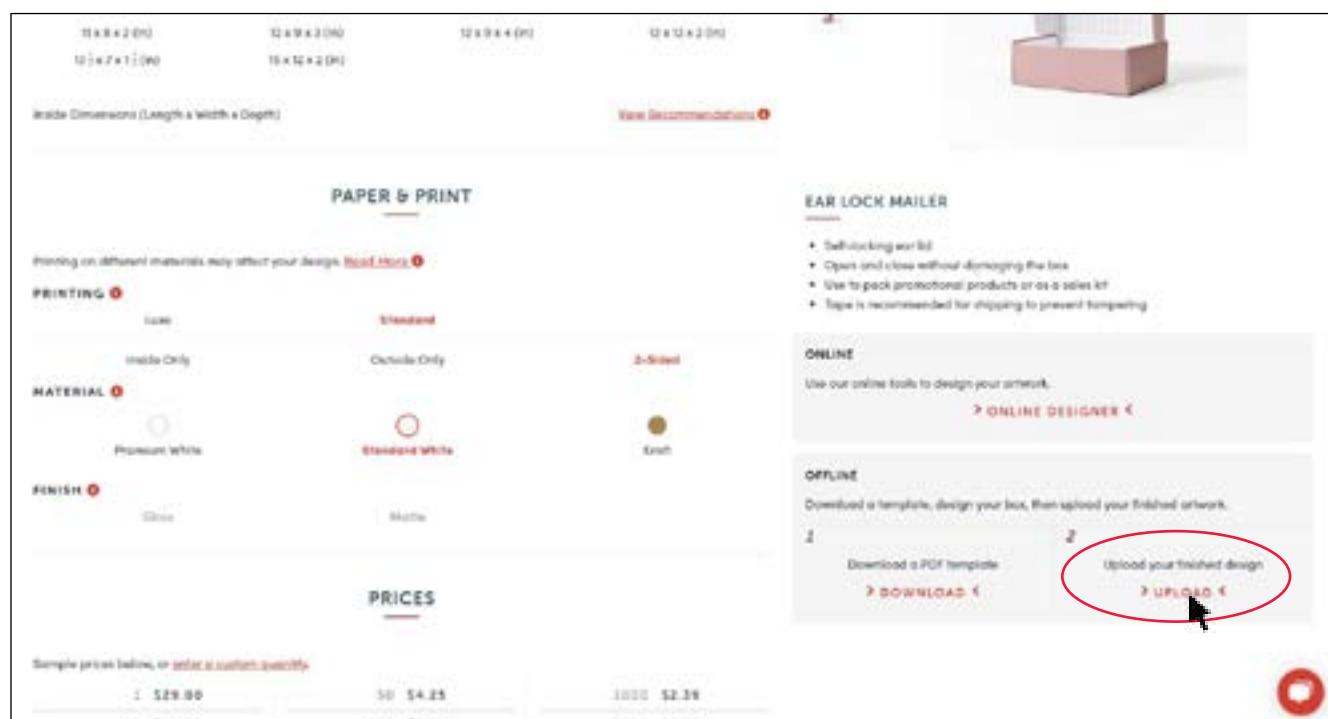
Red = Fold line (where the box will be folded)

Green = Bleed line (where the artwork should end. This is outside of the cut line to protect against possible printing shifts.)

- Add a new layer for art and drag that layer below the layer with the template on it. You should place all your designs on this art layer.



4. Get creative! Be sure to carry all artwork to the green bleed lines.
5. Save file as a PDF. If applicable, save inside and outside designs as separate PDFs.
6. Log back into companybox.com. Choose the Category and Style to match your design.
7. Choose "Upload Design".



8. Drop in your PDF when prompted.

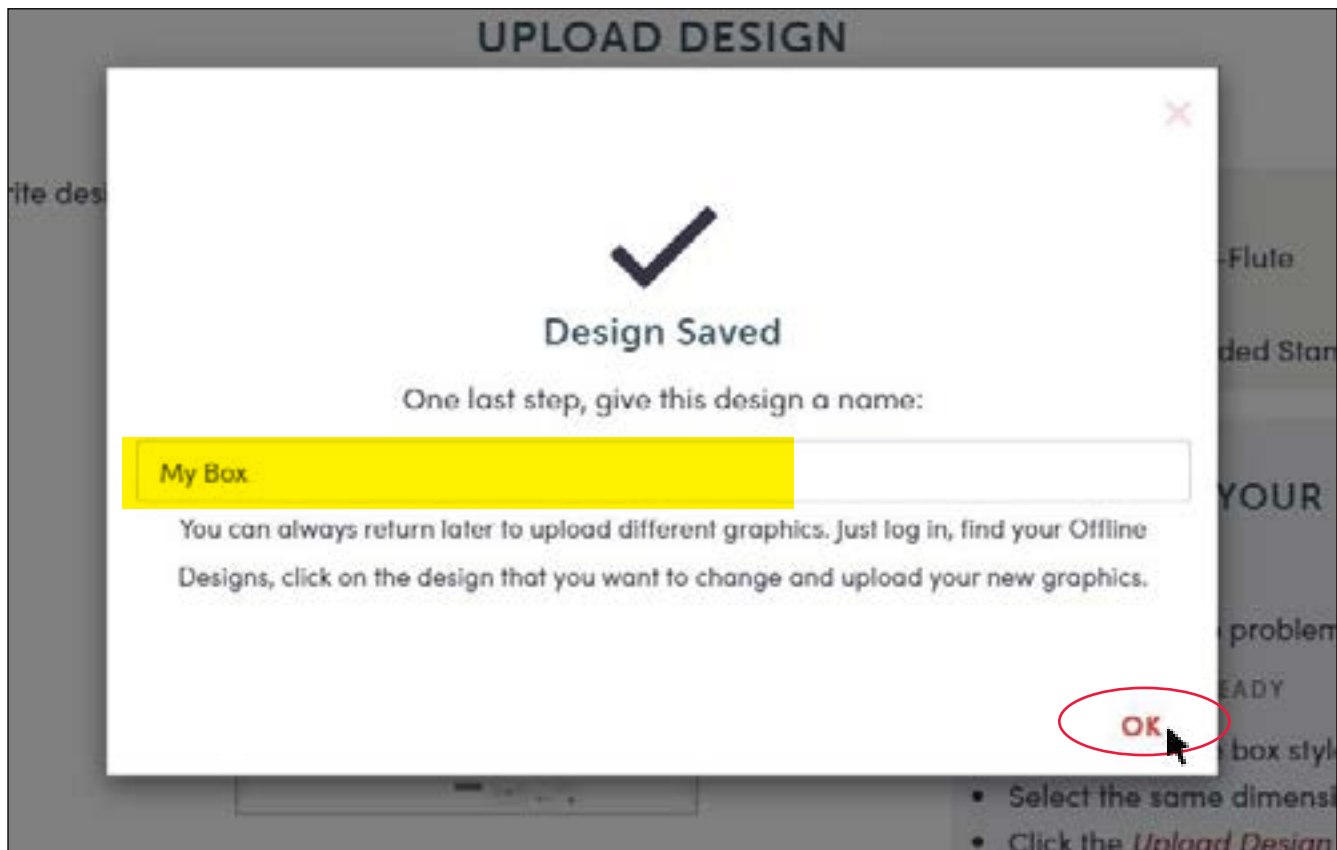
 *If you have designed an outside and inside print, be sure to upload these in separate PDFs.*



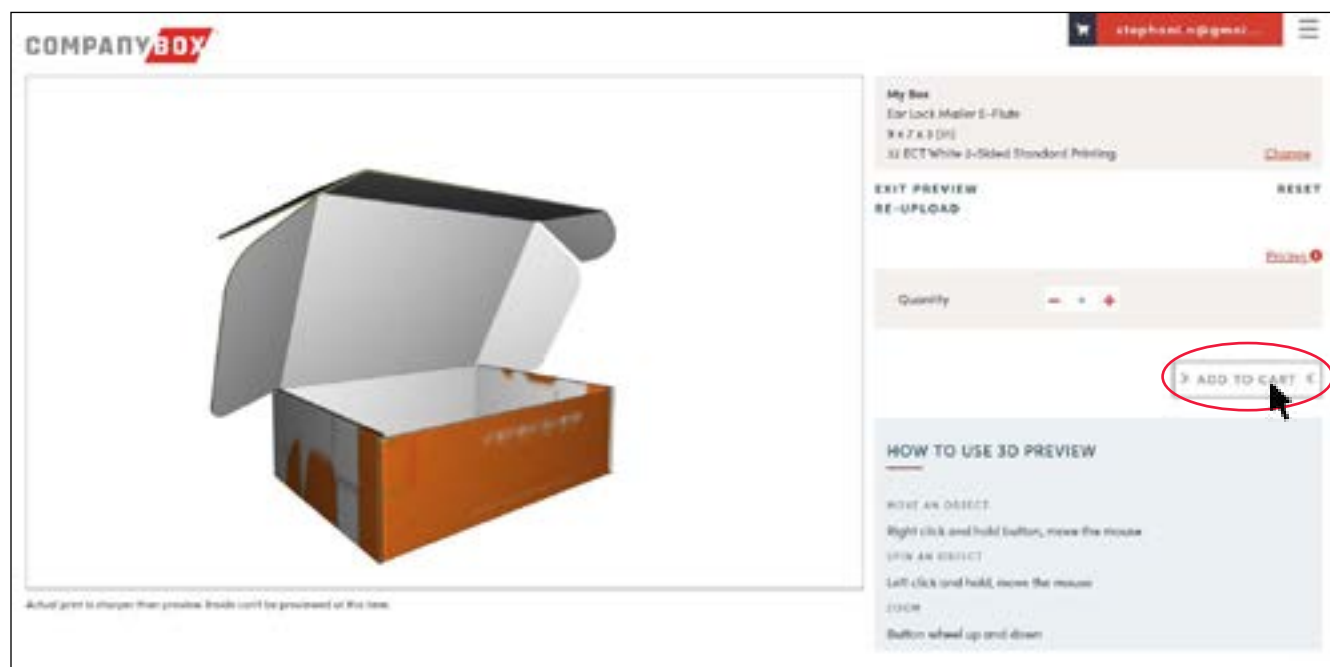
9. Click "PREVIEW".



10. Give your box a name. Click "OK".



11. Review Preview and, if approved, click "ADD TO CART".



12. Sit back and relax. We'll handle the printing.

Please Note!

- ➔ All images should be at least 300dpi, but no more than 600dpi.
- ➔ Do not use exact structural colors in your design. (Colors from cut, crease, annotation or bleed lines.)
- ➔ If the artboard has been rotated or adjusted, your file will not print correctly.
