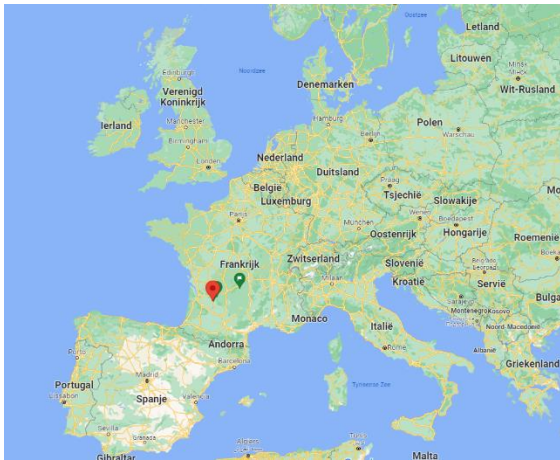
Carassonne \ka.ʁa.sɔ̃n\ [regional language from southwest of France near Bordeaux, noun]

- vine stake
 - Grapevines need support when they grow to keep them from dropping or breaking once the heavy grape bunches develop. A simple way to support them is to use stakes, contributing to the solidity and stability of the row, traditionally out of chestnut.

The Dordogne is a large rural department in Southwestern France, renowned for its love of food and drink – and boasts a long culinary heritage and a fabulous gastronomic heritage. The Dordogne is also known for its wine, walnut, strawberries and as the foie gras, duck and truffle capital of France.



Historically called Périgord, the Dordogne is popular for many good reasons: most beautiful villages in France, diverse natural landscapes from gorges and rocky plateaus to caves, medieval churches, and renaissance buildings. There are more than 1,500 castles in Dordogne, making it "The Other Chateau Country".

In the middle of nature, surrounded by vineyards and prune trees, the restored authentic building from the 19th century is made up of 3 lodges (or 'gîtes') that can convert into 1 large vacation home. The property is accessible for guests with disabilities, has a swimming pool, 'jeu de boules' and a private terrasse for each lodge.



The interior offers a combination of styles with both modern/loft design elements and the original features of the building with sandstone walls and oak roof and pillars.
