

# Creative Brief for Cover Design of *Radical Expansion: A Guide To Being God*

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## Overview & Concept

*Radical Expansion* is a groundbreaking work that blends ancient wisdom, modern science, and personal experience to explore the fundamental truth that **You Are God**. The book guides readers on a transformative journey from the illusion of separateness to the realisation of their divine nature, empowering them to live a life of purpose, joy, and interconnectedness with all things. ## Key Themes to Convey

4. **Blending science and spirituality:** The cover should reflect a **fusion of the mystical and the scientific** (separated by illusion) — inviting modern readers who appreciate science as much as they do spiritual wisdom.

## Target Audience

- **Primary audience:** Women aged 30-70, particularly those who are spiritually curious but feel disconnected from traditional religious institutions. They seek purpose, balance, and healing and value a blend of mysticism and science. Many are well-educated, busy professionals or semi-retirees, yearning for deeper meaning.

## Tone & Aesthetic

1. **Expansive and inspirational:** The cover should inspire awe and curiosity, encouraging readers to dive into life's deepest mysteries.

- **Tree of life/nature elements:** Include subtle natural elements like a **Tree of Life**, which could ground the spiritual with the earthly, symbolising growth, life, and connection to nature.

## Colour Palette

- **Deep blues and purples:** To evoke the mystery of the universe and the subconscious mind.
- **Golden or white light:** To symbolise enlightenment, divinity, and the awakening of consciousness.
- **Earthy greens and browns:** To represent the grounded, natural aspects of life, connecting the cosmic with the tangible.
- **Black and white:** To symbolise the illusion of duality in a world connected on levels it does not understand.

## Typography
