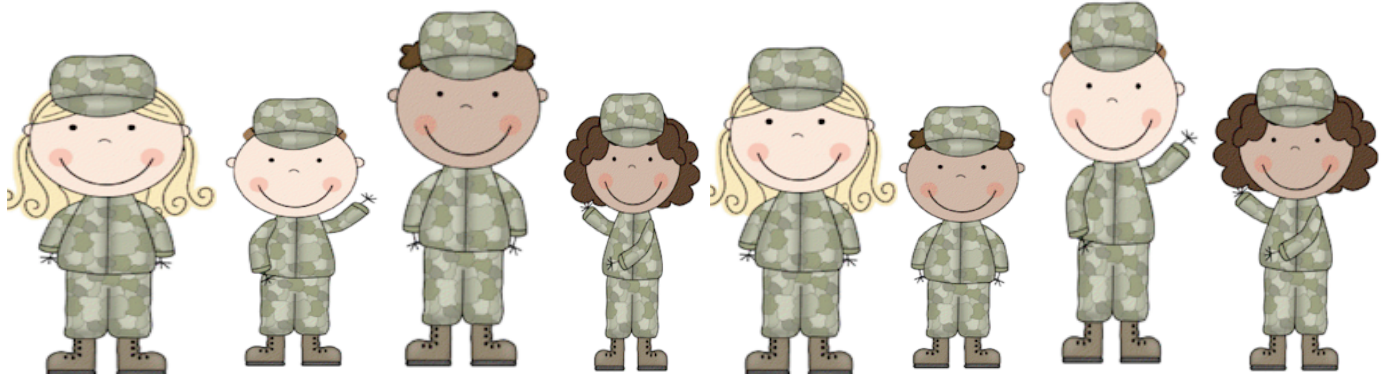




Selective Mutism Boot Camp 'n Family Fun Day!

The purpose for this intensive, but fun, one-day therapeutic camp is for families to learn hands-on treatment strategies, attend a variety of parent/child workshops, hear children/parents speak out about their experiences while being with others who understand in a comfortable, stress-free environment.

Families will be grouped with other similar-aged children and interact with S-CAT® counselors throughout the day or they can choose a less structured day while learning and meeting others during the day. Or, families can decide on a combination of both experiences! However, they choose, families will have a wonderful & memorable experience as they meet others and enjoy a day long family picnic/BBQ at an established child's day camp (40+ acres!) filled with countless activities that include; swimming with slides, boating, playground, mini golf nature trails, basketball, hay rides, tennis, pony rides, face painting, & MORE!
