
## THE GREATEST WEALTH IS HOPE.


## About Us HOPE FOR TOMORROW

Hope for Tomorrow (HOPE) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization based in Rockville, Maryland dedicated to providing health-care, human services, infrastructure, and educational assistance to the disadvantaged communities. HOPE originally started as a small group of friends getting together to participate in various community service projects. As the number of service projects increased, the group started to grow. In August 2006, Hope for Tomorrow was born.

The HOPE team has blossomed into a strong cohesive team with strong grass roots support. To better serve the disadvantaged communities, the HOPE team started sponsoring a variety of programs such as micro-finance, infrastructure improvements and build out, health and human services, senior support network and many others.

The HOPE team successfully completed over a dozen dental and medical missions, hosted over five free dental clinics, built an orphanage for children living with HIV/AIDS, built a cancer center, installed water filtration systems, worked in collaboration with other non-profits to conduct micro-finance programs and worked extensively with local community leaders to fashion programs to help those in need.

Working both locally and globally, the Hope for Tomorrow team is dedicated to serving the disadvantaged communities.

## GRAND CHALLENGE PROJECT TAN DINH HOSPITAL MODERNIZATION

The Hope for Tomorrow's (HOPE) Grand Challenge Project is to institute a transformational change for Tan Dinh Hospital in Saigon, Vietnam to become a world class accountable care organization so it can serve the community. The net revenue generated will be used to offset the cost for providing care to the disadvantaged communities. The profits gained will be used to reinvest in the community in the form of providing better health care and establishing a more health aware and conscious community. For the transformation to take place, the HOPE team will need an array of assistance ranging from financial, technological, administrative and personnel. The Grand Challenge Project is a two phase approach.

In Phase 1, the Grand Challenge Project team entails raising funds to help modernize the Tan Dinh Hospital infrastructure. Infrastructure modernization includes re-equipping all examination rooms, operatory, surgical, pharmacy, pediatric and dental suites.


In Phase 2, the Grand Challenge Project team will engage in recruitment and retraining of Tan Dinh Hospital staff to be more patient centric and service oriented. Phase 2 will also include crafting better educational and outreach campaigns to help bring the community closer to the Tan Dinh Hospital.

## HOPE CHALLENGE PROJECTS

### THE GARY HOUSE

The Mai Tam Cancer Center is an institution dedicated to helping those battling cancer. The Gary House is the first unit to be built and its fashion against the Ronald McDonald House philosophy. The Gary House project was initiated in 2012. The building was completed in the Fall of 2013. The grand opening held on January 12, 2014 in Thu Duc District, Saigon, Vietnam. From January 2014 to present, the Gary House is helping to host over 60+ cancer patients and their family members.

### MAI TAM ORPHANAGE

The Mai Tam Orphanage for Children living with HIV/AIDS opened its doors 2009. The Mai Tam House of Hope (aka Mai Tam Center) is a home and center for HIV/AIDS positive widows, mothers, and children that provides shelter, medicine, medical care, education, and referrals for its residents and the many walk-ins it receives in need of support. The children living at Mai Tam are both infected and affected by HIV/AIDS. Some are HIV positive or have AIDS and some are the children or orphans of persons with HIV/AIDS. The Mai Tam Center provides a safe nurturing haven to help its residence gain more self-esteem, grow and become a contributing member of their community. Today, the Mai Tam Center, the first and still the only facility of its kind in Saigon, supports more than 500 women and children in need.

### DENTAL AND MEDICAL MISSIONS


Hope for Tomorrow's first dental and medical mission was to Da Nang, Vietnam in 2005. The corner stone of HOPE is conducting annual dental and medical missions to help the disadvantaged communities. Currently, the HOPE team concentrates its international mission works in Vietnam and Cambodia. The mission provides free dental and medical care to those who do not have access and cannot afford the care. Usually, the dental and medical missions will run between seven to ten days. The HOPE mission team includes both health professionals and non-health professionals. The team diversity is a major strength for the HOPE team.

### DOMESTIC DENTAL CLINICS

After conducting over a dozen international dental and medical missions, the HOPE team brought the knowledge from conducting the missions overseas to serve the local community. For the past couple of years, the HOPE team has been hosting free dental clinics to help the disadvantage communities in the Washington D.C. metropolitan area. The free dental clinic usually runs for one day. The HOPE dental team is able to treat between 100 – 300 patients a day. With capital investments, ingenuity and a dedicated volunteer team, the HOPE dental clinic is poised to provide necessary dental care.

### MICRO FINANCE

The HOPE micro-finance initiative (HOPE MiFi) is managed by Dr. Tara Nga VanToai. Dr. VanToai is the Program Director for the HOPE MiFi. HOPE MiFi's mission is to provide working capital to women in the lowest income brackets in Vietnam and other developing countries so they can engage in income producing activities to better their life and the life of their family. HOPE MiFi works closely with L'Association VietNam Entraide et Solidarité (AVNES - <http://www.avenes.org>). AVNES has extensive experience conducting micro-finance projects in Vietnam. In the initial pilot micro finance project, HOPE provided the funds and AVNES served as the funds manager. From this partnership, the HOPE MiFi program grew and expanded. ### MICRO FINANCE

### HOPE RUNNERS

Hope for Tomorrow is a member of Marathon Charity Cooperation (MCC). MCC is a 501(c)(3) charitable and educational organization that conducts several running events a year. MCC is a member of the National Co-op Business Association, Road Runners Club of America (RRCA), and USA Track & Field (USATF). Each year, the HOPE team staffs aid stations for the Alexandria Running Festival Half Marathon and other events hosted by MCC. The HOPE team also recruits runners for several marathons which MCC participates in. For the 2014 Marine Corp Marathon in Washington D.C., the following runners were recruited to run on behalf of HOPE: Anthony Costanzo, Anh Ta, Dat Le, Duy Vu, Tuan Nguyen, Jessica Stone and Louise Hoang.

### WATER FILTRATION SYSTEMS


In third world countries, water borne illness is the number one killer of children and adults. For those with access to potable water, it is a luxury. A small team of HOPE volunteers have helped to install water filtration systems and water wells in remote villages, churches, temples and community centers in Vietnam. The water filtration system is designed to provide a source of good potable water and also a source of revenue. The potable water is sold to local residents at a very cheap rate. The revenue generated is used to provide upkeep of the filtration systems and purchase additional supplies like filters and water bottles.

### SENIOR SUPPORT - FRIENDS GROUP & VOLUNTEERS

From the very beginning of Hope for Tomorrow, the primary focus was providing care for children. However through the years, the experiences derived from many international dental and medical mission started to alter HOPE's focus a little bit. Today, a team of HOPE volunteers who called themselves the Friends Group gather quarterly to provide financial and material supports to very poor senior citizens living in extreme conditions in Vietnam. The Friends Group provide monetary, material and emotional support. Through the love and care, the Friends Group have ignited the flame of hope in the senior members of the community.

### ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Since 2009, Hope for Tomorrow has been working with the Vietnam Student Development Funds (VNSDF) headed by Dr. Do Huynh Phi of Switzerland to provide needed academic scholarships to undergraduates and graduates students. The tuition for one academic year at a university in Vietnam cost ranges from \$250 to \$500 per student. The students are primarily from very poor economic background. The students receiving scholarships have very high academic scores and needs a little catalyst to help change their future. The HOPE and VNSDF scholarship goal is to inspire students to cultivate free, independent and creative thinking, intellectual power, strengthen their character, professional competences, ethical conduct and a sense of social and environmental responsibility for the progressive and sustainable development of society. To date, HOPE and VNSDF has provide scholarships to 125+ students (90% college and 10% high school students). HOPE and VNSDF is looking for more donations and sponsors to help foster a generation of bright students in Vietnam.

### DR. HOA TRUNG PHAM


