Minimum Logo Width - 14mm

14mm is the safest minimum size.





BACKGROUND DO'S


Whenever possible, the Smart Plus Logo should be used on a white or light background. For those application that require a background color, the following guidelines should be followed.




BACKGROUND DON'TS

Avoid using the Smart Plus Logo on a busy background or backgrounds with the similar color of the Smart Plus logo.


Don't use the logo on a pattern or photographic background.



For dark backgrounds, use grey version whenever possible.



Don't use the logo on a background color that is similar to the colors in the logo.



When color spot (CMYK) is not available, use the single color version



...use the white version instead
