

KNIFE RIVER MOBILE HOME PARK

Knife River Mobile Home Park: located in Stanton, North Dakota. It will accommodate full and part-time residents. Residents will be living in manufactured homes (single and double wide) as well as RV's and campers.

Stanton, North Dakota: is the county seat with approximate population of 500. It is a seasonal, recreational community and supports many species of fish and wildlife—Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Coyote, Fox, Native Grouse, Pheasant, etc. The area is experiencing an influx of oil field workers.

Knife River: a tributary of the Missouri River - approximately 120 miles long — in North Dakota. It joins the Missouri north of Stanton. The Missouri River has provided a transportation system for both Indian and Euro-American trappers and traders.

Sakakawea: a Shoshone Indian woman, led Lewis and Clark on their 1804-1805 expedition up the Missouri River. North Dakota has a Lake Sakakawea State Park.
