

Splash Screen


This is the screen that shows while loading up. As soon as games are available, we fade to the next screen.



Games


With pull-to-refresh, this view shows all of the games that have been saved by this particular user, or shared with this user.



Parents can quickly update scores without missing the game by flicking up & down on the scorecards.


The view on bottom is a stopwatch with controls for starting/stopping the game, setting time, or viewing photos taken during the game.



Teams


The teams view lists all teams that the current parent has access to.

Touching one of the teams opens up the team edit view.




Team Edit
