
Directory Advertising Specifications Guide



Client Supplied Artwork

Artwork for directory advertising can be forwarded to Local Directories™ in the following formats:

Preferred

- InDesign (CS4 or earlier)
- Illustrator (CS4 or earlier) AI/EPS
- Photoshop (CS4 or earlier) PSD/TIFF/JPG/EPS
- Highest resolution/print quality PDF
- QuarkXPress (6.5 or earlier)

Colour

All files are to be supplied in CMYK/Greyscale/Bitmap format.

Fonts

All fonts are to be supplied or text is to be converted to outlines or paths. If fonts are not supplied with artwork, similar fonts will be substituted from our library.

Scanned Images

All scanned images are to be a minimum of 300dpi (600dpi Bitmap) and saved in TIFF/JPG format at a size relative to their placement in the final advertisement. Original photos (hard copies) can be scanned in-house and returned to clients at a later date if necessary.

All support files are to be included separately with layers if applicable (no embedded files).

Proofs

All supplied artwork is to be accompanied by a laser printout. All clients receive a laser colour proof for approval of their artwork. We strongly advise clients to carefully check advertisement proofs and notify us, either of any changes or corrections required, or the approval of the advertisement. All possible care is taken in the making of the advertisement, however no responsibility can be accepted for printing conditions outside our control, including registration and colour variation.

Cover

Outside Front Cover	175 lines per inch
Outside Back Cover	175 lines per inch

Printed on	Gloss artboard

Advertisement Colour Options

White (W) Full Colour

Any colour (including white) is allowed in the advertisement, without restrictions.

Dual Colour (DC)

Any two of our exclusive pre-mixed colours, Red, Blue, Green can be added to a standard advertisement (Black). Shades of these colours can be used. No white is allowed.

Dual Colour CMYK %

Colour	Cyan	Magenta	Yellow	Black
DC Red	0	100	90	0
DC Blue	100	30	0	5
DC Green	100	0	90	0
DC Yellow	0	0	30	0

No Colour (NC)

Black and shades of black printed on yellow paper create our standard advertisement format. No white is allowed.
