

Create jQuery Mobile themeroller compliant CSS and icons for a mobile web app.

Task Description:

Spartan Solutions are in the process of implementing a new, web based version of their Phalanx operations platform.



The web based version of Phalanx is built on top of the jQuery Mobile platform and we are looking for a designer to create a jQuery Mobile themeroller compliant CSS theme pack that we can plug into our application. The aim is to remove the standard jQuery Mobile look and feel and to introduce the Spartan branding throughout the new web app.



A number of screenshots are listed below that show what the current (Windows Mobile 6.5) application looks like, alongside the development version of our new web app.

<p>A readonly list is displayed on this screen. Currently the header bar and background is themed to match the theming of the current active process.</p>	

Form Step	
Windows Mobile 6.5 Client	New Web App Client (Dev Version)
	
<p>This step is used by the user to capture an arbitrary amount of data. Supports all HTML data input types.</p>	

Lookup Step	
Windows Mobile 6.5 Client	New Web App Client (Dev Version)
	
<p>This step is used when searching a database. The user can select what they want to search by and the results are displayed in a list below the search fields.</p>	

We are looking for a fresh, clean, modern design that incorporates the Spartan branding but the experience is not radically different from the old Windows Mobile client (as shown above) as we do not want to alienate/re-train our existing customers.

- jQuery Mobile (v 1.4.2) themeroller compliant CSS which provides theming for all jQuery Mobile UI components.
