

eLearning page & support elements

The requirement to design the skin and supporting elements for an eLearning module. These are:

1. A main/home page (970 x 690 pixels)
2. A similar look 'pop-up' page (776x552 pixels) – can be the same just smaller.
3. A series of buttons/tabs/menu to assist in navigating the module

This would be similar to the design of a webpage with the element required on the page listed below.

The eLearning module will be used by employees to navigate through a series of courses covering company information. The client manages cemeteries (but has a sense of humour!) Their staff are mostly (middle-aged) women. The online learning modules will be fun and interesting and they plan to use a cartoon character called "Winston" with callout bubbles to 'narrate' text. (Please let me know if you have cartoon skills as this will be a separate design project).

Please note! If you are interested in this project, focus on the main page layout and a few example buttons. Please don't create all buttons or the pop-up page unless we ask you to. We believe this will save everyone time and ensure we only progress to the full brief where we have a serious interest.

Example Pages (currently)

FYI, this is what I created... I'm not a designer, I'm using an elearning program to build the content and I need you to do the design. The client may get the cartoon characters redesigned. We just want to create a fairly generic skin that is easy on the eye and will give the learning credibility.

Main/Home Page requirements

Page dimensions are 970 x 690 pixels and should incorporate the following elements:

- 1) Navigation buttons (Back, Next, Close, Site Map, Help, Links, Home)
- 2) Table of Contents. If this is a list it needs to be at least 180 pixels wide x 240 pixels tall, but it can be a simple dropdown box.
- 3) Menu containing (Home, Help, Resources, Links – possibly more)
- 4) Company Logo – see example below
- 5) Module Title - that is the name of the training module
- 6) Page Title – that is the subject matter covered on the page
- 7) Text box (either one large, two small, may be in a callout bubble spoken by a cartoon character)
- 8) Palette of all colours used in the scheme

Please note: this is for an e-learning module. It would be helpful if the buttons are simple enough to replicate if we need to create additional ones later.

Pop-up Page requirements

The page layout may be simpler but follow the same theme. Page is smaller (800x600). It contains fewer elements, specifically:

- 1) Navigation buttons (Close, Print)
- 2) Page Title
- 3) Content – this will be text with an image or a map

Navigation Button Requirements

We require a series of buttons which will be used to navigate to specific pages, buttons are:

- **Quiz** – user quiz for the section
- **History** page
- **Maps** page – click to jump to the maps page
 - Map Overview “**Cemetery Location**” – where a cemetery is located in the city area
 - Map Detail “**Cemetery Map**” – layout of the cemetery
- **Contact** details
- **Directions** (i.e. driving and public transport)
 - Public Transport (Train or bus)
 - By Car
- **Services** (i.e. Toilets, Coffee Shop, Chapel)
- Burial **Sections** (to indicate whether it’s a Tomb, Vault, Lawn Grave, Crypt)
- In addition we need a general navigation which will contain the name of the Cemetery Page. They need to be wide but not high (e.g. 150pix x 30pix) e.g. “**Field of Mars**”.

The text in bold is the text we think should be written on the buttons.

The buttons could appear as independent buttons or merge with the Header/navigation area and only display when relevant.

I need the button to be supplied in three formats so I can build them into my system:

- Normal
- Hover – a change when a mouse is placed over
- Click – a change (maybe move the button picture elements down and right 1-2 pixels)
